Gas Furnaces: \$4941

New gas furnace efficiency standards will cost consumers an additional \$494 on average.

New energy standards would force families to purchase models that are \$2,800 more expensive.

New fuel economy regulation on SUVs and pickup trucks will increase up-front prices by \$932 per unit.



New light bulb standards cost families an average of \$140 to light their homes



New standards for washing machines would increase per-unit prices by roughly \$200.

Air Conditioner: \$1,100



Outlawing R-22 refrigerants will dramatically hike prices to refill traditional air conditioning units.



Dishwashers: \$225

Drainage problems resulting from new efficiency standards leads to clogging, which can cost between \$50 and \$400 to repair.



Gas Stoves \$800 - \$3.250

Bans of future gas stoves would force consumers to install new electric outlets (approx. \$350), and purchase new electric models costing between \$450 and \$2,800.



Ceiling Fans: \$25

New proposed regulations would cost consumers about \$10 per fan. The average U.S. household has two to three ceiling fans.









Gas Furnaces: \$494

The Biden administration estimates a new rule cracking down on gas furnace efficiency standards will cost consumers an additional \$494 on average.





Water Heaters: \$2.800 **↑**

Proposed Biden administration energy efficiency standards for water heaters would require new boiler installations to use electric heat pumps, which are roughly \$2,800 more expensive than standard electric models.





Cars: \$932

The Biden administration estimates a proposed automotive fuel economy regulation on SUVs and pickup trucks will increase upfront prices by \$932 per unit.





Air Conditioning: \$1,100

The Biden administration's move to outlaw R-22 refrigerants will dramatically hike prices to refill traditional air conditioning units.



Ceiling Fans: \$25

The Biden administration estimates proposed regulations on ceiling fans would cost consumers about \$10 per fan. The average U.S. household has two to three ceiling fans.



Light Bulbs: \$140

The administration's effective ban on incandescent light bulbs means Americans will have to switch to bulbs that are \$3.50 more expensive on average. The average American household has more than 40 light bulb sockets.





Dishwashers: \$225

A proposed Biden administration regulation would prevent effective flushing of food particles, leading to drainage problems and clogging, which can cost between \$50 and \$400 to repair.





Gas Stoves \$800 - \$3,250

New proposed Biden administration rules banning future gas stoves (which are already being instituted in some progressive cities) would force consumers to install new electric outlets (approx. \$350), and purchase new electric models costing between \$450 and \$2.800.









Washing Machines: \$200 ★

Manufacturers say proposed Biden administration energy efficiency standards for washing machines would increase perunit prices by roughly \$200.
